Together, Farm Rescue and Can-Am are helping protect a way of life, strengthening communities and preserving agricultural traditions for future generations.

- A custom Farm Rescue wrapped top-of-the-line utility workhorse 2026 Can-Am Defender MAX Lone Star Cab HD11 that will be auctioned to leverage additional funds for Farm Rescue's mission

As part of the partnership, Can-Am also becomes “the official utility vehicle of Farm Rescue.”
